

• The Virtual Tour includes 7 ZOOM connections on 7 different days, consecutive, weekly, monthly, or other.

A school may purchase the complete Virtual Tour (seven connections) or select a single city.

• The duration of each connection on each of the established days ranges from a minimum of about 40 minutes to a maximum of about 60 minutes. The single session option will be of 60 minutes.

• The connection time must be between 7:00 am and 12 (noon) (NY time) for reasons related to the US/ITALY time difference.

• The link for the ZOOM connection is sent by SuperciaoTour to the Teacher/School/Manager the day before each connection (we suggest conducting a test ahead of the appointed time).

• SuperciaoTour always opens the connection 10 minutes before the start of the Tour, to allow the group or individuals to access it and greet each other.

• The ZOOM connection can take place with the group gathered in a classroom or auditorium or the like, or with several groups connected from different classrooms or with individual participants (min 25 participants).

Schools may also choose to divide the tour package among various grade levels or classes by permitting each group to visit a different city. In so doing more students will benefit from the experience.

• The Teacher/School/Manager books the Virtual Tour's date and time directly on the website: BOOKING button.

• SuperciaoTour approves the choice of time and date or requests modifications according to organizational needs and the Tour Guides' availability.



## Tour Leader/Specialized Guides: Language Used

The cities, monuments, and works of art are illustrated by specialized Guides who speak in the language chosen by the Group: English or Italian.
